

MEDICAL EMERGENCY REPORT

What is a medical emergency? Any injury where an ambulance is called, or a person (player, spectator, official or coach) is being taken to an emergency facility or any injury that requires more than five minutes to treat on the field. (Note: Do not attempt to move anybody who shows signs of a neck or head trauma or anyone who has suffered a compound fracture. Call 911)

Who must fill out this report? Any referee, referee assistant, coach or club official who witnesses a medical emergency must fill out a report.

Filing the report. Notify Villa Hills Soccer Club at 684-4893 immediately of any major injury. Copies of the report must be mailed to VHSC within 24 hours of the incident at PO Box 17101, Covington, KY 41017-0101.
